

82. RIEGSECKER

To my knowledge there are no Riegseckers or Riegsecker descendants in Canada. However, Anna Roth (also known as Anneli), the youngest daughter of Hans Roth (1740-1802) and Verena Stucky (? - 1802) married John Riegsecker. Two of her brothers just older than herself -- Michael and Joseph Roth were immigrants to Canada -- hence one of our interests in the Riegsecker family.
